### Hub Sen 140

#### Set of 3 sensory resources

- Flashing light star
- Colour stacking bell
- Twisting wooden worm



### Hub Sen 136

#### USB Audio Ball

- Three colour LED - red/green/blue.
- Built-In microphone synchronizes lights to sounds in the room.
- Bendable gooseneck arm for positioning.
- Universal USB Connectivity - Powered by USB, no messy AC cord and adapter required: easily connect to laptop, TV or ION powered speaker (like ION's Block Rocker)



### Hub Sen 134

#### Sensory buckle pillow

Features;

- Connect the same locks together,
- The built-in sound paper squeaks.
- There is a threading game under the lock. This fine motor development toy is easier to attract children's attention

### Sensory Stacking Blocks

- The blocks have a variety of patterns, include animals, numbers, shapes, textures and fruits
- Soft with no sharp edges and squeak when squeezed
- Helps develop motor skills

### Tactile mittens – set of 8

Each mitten has a different texture. This is a great way of learning what textures are enjoyable through tactile stimulation.

Textures are;

Soft, spotty, rough, fleecy, silky, bumpy, ridged.

- Cause & effect
- Turn the handle, music plays and wait for Jack to pop up!

### Black and White spinning disc – with 5 changeable boards

- Visual
- Good for children who have an interest in things that spin/turn.

## Hub Sen 75

### Shiny Treasure Basket – large (adult supervision required)

- Contains metal objects to explore.
- For developing multi-sensory, fine motor, thinking and creative skills.
- Children can explore the objects and the sounds they make when they are banged together.
- Items include;
  - Oval metal plates
  - Mini kettle
  - Foil blanket
  - Spoons, pasta fork, palette knife
  - Trivet
  - Jug
  - Measuring cups
  - Mini masher
  - Bowl and dish
  - Mini pans and lid



## Hub Sen 34

### Spinning Jewel

- Good for children who enjoy things that spin
- When turning the spinning top, the coloured jewels appear to mix together



## Hub Sen 37

### Mini Mirror wooden spinning box

- Different mirrored surfaces faced with acrylic mirror and diffractive finishes.
- Spin the box round on its stand and enjoy watching light being reflected and diffracted back at you.



## Hub Sen 50

### Wooden Treasure cylinder rolling pins x 3

- Cylinders filled with treasure like items to capture children's interest.
- Ideal for sensory and exploration activities. Children can roll, shake, twist and turn them.
- Can be used in dough as well as in the role play area and have acrylic centres so the contents can be seen.
- Light wood containing bells, jewels and fish.



## Hub Sen 94

### Rotating musical bobble balls

- Cause and effect.
- Twist base and music will play.
- The coloured balls are on springs so moveable when touched.

### Wooden spin and roll

- Cause and effect
- Turn it over and watch the shiny object zigzag down the track

### Mirror Chimeabout

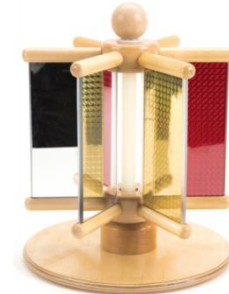
- New Chimeabout design with thick sturdy spindles.

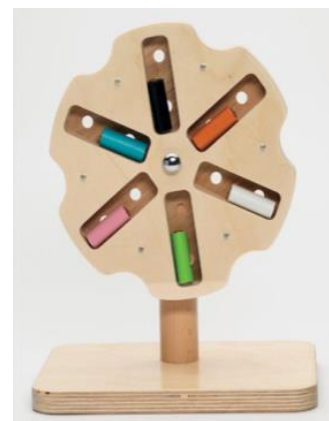

## Hub Sen 62

### Rotating Wood Mill

- This rotating wood mill is ideal for instigating auditory and visual stimulation. The enclosed marbles and wooden pieces clack up and down the tracks as the mill is turned. The wooden frame is sturdy and robust. Suitable from birth upwards or for children functioning at this developmental stage.
- Wooden rotating spirals, ideal for engagement and curiosity.
- As the child spins the wooden top, they can watch the contents rotate and hear the bells and sounds chime as they move around the wooden casing. Each spiral has a different effect that is equally engaging.
- Enjoyable play-based learning, great for helping young children's developing coordination and encourage them to explore.
- Ideal for children who like things to spin/turn.

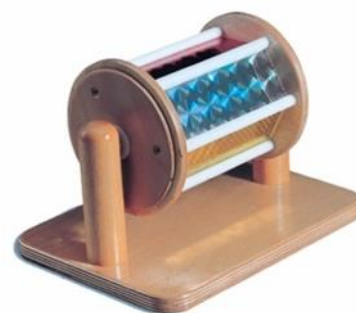

## Hub Sen 64
