How often meetings will be held: Four times per annum

Membership: Seven – including Headteacher and one Associate Governor

- 1. To be rigorous and robust in supporting the development of the children at the school through the relevant policies and strategies.
- 2. To ensure all relevant policies are implemented, reviewed and developed as necessary in support of the Senior Leadership Team.
- 3. To monitor how well the curriculum reflects the learning and development needs of the children.
- 4. To oversee self-evaluation.
- 5. To monitor the delivery of the School Improvement Plan.
- 6. To find out about the progress the children are making and offer an element of challenge through monitoring and evaluation of this progress.
- 7. To report our findings back to the Governing Board.
