**How often meetings will be held:** Four times per annum

**Membership:** Seven – including Headteacher and one Associate Governor

4. To oversee self-evaluation.

6. To find out about the progress the children are making and offer an element of challenge through monitoring and evaluation of this progress.
7. To report our findings back to the Governing Board.
